Winterfest 2018

Dear Parents,

The Sherbrooke Academy Senior entire staff and student body will be kicking off our Winter Carnival by taking part in a Ski/Tubing day on Monday, February 26, 2018. This day will be held at Mont-Avila. The students will have the option of choosing either tubing OR ski/snowboarding. **No rentals or lessons will be provided. Students are expected to be proficient skiers/snowboarders for this option.** Guaranteed fun for everyone!

We are thrilled to have this event subsidised thanks to our Innovative Grant, making it much more affordable for all. For just \$23 your child will enjoy a day of skiing/snowboarding or tubing with busing included.

Please note that the skiing option does not include lessons or equipment rental. Your child should already know how to ski/snowboard on their own and have their own equipment. All students will use the buddy system and will ski in small groups with a teacher. The students will only be allowed to ski on the beginner and intermediate hills until they are evaluated by a teacher. They will have to demonstrate their proficiency to be able to ski on the black diamond runs. If the teacher deems them capable, they will have permission from that staff member to go on black diamond runs. If any student is caught on one of the black diamond runs without a staff member's permission, they will lose their right to ski/snowboard for the rest of the day.

We ask that all students bring snacks, lunch and have plenty of water to drink. We are trying to make this a litter-less event; anything that goes to the event comes back home (i.e. a Tupperware container). **Please note that students are NOT allowed to bring money to use at the cafeteria, everyone MUST bring a lunch.** Also, make sure that your child is dressed appropriately as he/she will be outdoors for most of the day. An extra pair of socks, gloves and hat might be a good idea.

Quick reminder that students are **not permitted** to bring any kind of electronic games/devices with them. Also note that if the weather does not cooperate, there is NO RAIN DATE for this activity, the event will be cancelled and money will be refunded.

TRANSPORT: School bus

NEED: Helmets are **MANDATORY** – no helmet, no sliding/skiing! Any kind of helmet will do, whether it's a ski, bike, hockey or any other kind of helmet, your child needs one. If your child does not own one please make arrangements to borrow one from family or friends. Goggles are also **STRONGLY** recommended for both activities in order to protect the eyes and keep the face warm.

Please fill out the attached permission form and return it to your child's homeroom teacher along with your cheque for \$23 (made out to Sherbrooke Academy Sr.) by Friday, February 9, 2018. Make sure to check off whether your child will be tubing or skiing/snowboarding.
