#### 1. Recap of Home & School initiatives for December 2019 – Jan 14, 2020:

- Children's' Bazaar The annual Children's' bazaar was held December 13<sup>th</sup> at the Sr school. The children once again had fun purchasing gifts for their loved ones. Home & School had amazing support from parent volunteers & staff making this event a pleasure to host! A big thank you to all.
- Budget Approval: A special HnS meeting was held December 18 for the sole purpose of holding a vote for the 2019-20 budget. The budget passed unanimously and allots a total of \$4,000 to each campus to be spent as the principal sees fit. To date, the Jr. campus has chosen to utilize a portion of their budget on a new kitchen being installed in the Daycare area. This new kitchen will be utilized by for projects initiated by teachers (and their students), the daycare staff, and Home & School. An oven and refrigerator have been purchased and an evaluation of costs associated with the installation of cabinets & counters is ongoing.
- Teacher Allocation Refund Program- The program put in place has been utilized by some staff as we enter the new year. Teachers have the ability to purchase materials they require for their classes up to a value of \$50 which is to be reimbursed by the HnS Assn. No pre-approval for the purchase is required.
- Home & School Newsletter The first issue of the newsletter for the 2019-2020 academic year was sent out at the end of 2019. The next issue will be ready to be sent to parents at the beginning of February.

- Pizza and Subway lunches (2 lunches per month)
- Tea Trolleys for staff at both Campuses— once a month H&S parents donate baked goods and a "trolley" goes class to class so teachers can enjoy a quick tea/coffee and dessert break.
